- Possess at least a bachelor's degree or equivalent professional qualification in a relevant field.
- Have a minimum of five (5) years of professional experience in their area of expertise.
- Have experience serving in leadership, governance, advisory, or management roles.
- Be willing to dedicate time to Board meetings, committee assignments, and organizational events.
- Have no conflict of interest that may compromise their role as a Board member.

- Ensure sound governance and accountability.
- Approve and monitor organizational strategies, plans, and budgets.
- Support resource mobilization and partnership development.
- Oversee financial stewardship and risk management.
- Promote the visibility and credibility of FDHS.
- Advocate for the rights and inclusion of persons with disabilities.
- Participate actively in Board and committee meetings.

TERM OF SERVICE

Board members will serve for a term of three (3) years, renewable in accordance with the FDH Constitution and Governance Policies.

(i) A cover letter expressing interest and suitability for the position.

(ii) A detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV).

(iii) Names and contacts of two professional referees.

(iv) A brief statement (maximum two pages) outlining how they will contribute to advancing the mission and strategic goals of FDH.
